Dear Brother and Sister these lines lines lines are to
Inform you that we are well at present thanks be to God
For his mercies to us hoping to hear that you are well I have
least to George Bridgman ten Acres of your land for four
years and let J Bridgman have the old Improvement
one year Dear Brother you wrote to Me that you
Wold be out this fall to see us if God permit I was glad
to think of seeing you once more now Brother to the
object for my writing to you we are Building us a
Meeting hous in Cannonsburgh it is one mile from us
now Brother Finley if you can apoint the time
that you can be here God willing we will try to have
the house ready for Dedication and we want you
you present now if you can send us the time
that you can attend pray write to Me as soon
As you get these lines and let Me no what you can
do God willing I have named your name and character
As a Gospel Minister to members hear and there is a
great desire to see you and hearing your warning
voice pardon Me if I have Done wrong
Direct your answer to Hancock County
Cannons burgh Post office
