Yours addressed to Bro. Gay & my self
is at hand & contents noted. —

As soon as I receive a supply of
Blue Books. I will endeavor to send you one.
I have not any on hand & am worried in con-
sequence. — Several Applications are on hand
waiting their arrival & I am advised of two
more on the way. I hope to receive them
(the Blue Books) in a day or two. —

You ask relative to your duty when
inspecting Divisions —

I will simply say in reply that
you will see that divisions, comply with all
the rules laid down for their Government in the
Blue Book and the rules of the National and
Grand Division. — To effect this you are expected
to visit the each Division under your charge, at
least once before the expiration of the quarter. and
inspect their whole acts. — The mode of opening,
inviting, & their general business with their Books,
you are to note all irregularities and report
them to the G. W. D. — The general rules for the govt
of Deputies were published in the "Organ"
of last year.
