Chillicothe Sept 4th

My Dear friend
Many years ago when your father lived in Kentucky - he sent to my father two Virginia military warrants to be located, amounting to 333 1/2 acres, these warrants belonged to a man by the name of Jesse Moore and he must have lived in your fathers neighborhood in Kentucky. My object in writing to you is to know if you are or were acquainted with Jesse Moore and if so the place at which he lived. The land has never been sold, and we claim the one third part for the location and would like to inform the heirs of Moore of this interest - Your attention will much oblige me - My family is well - Mrs. Mapps joins me in love and respects
