My wife informs me, that you were to see me, on the Subject of surveying your lands East of Cinton, and that you wished me to do it, before I went out of office. —

I would be very glad, to do your work, but my whole time is promised, untill my Successor will probably receive his Commission. — I think it likely however, that I will have the privilege afterwards, of doing any work, officially, that the people of the County may want me to do, and that there will therefore, be no inconvenience arise to you, from my present inability, to comply with your wish in the matter.
