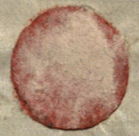

The fellow drinking, Langa Gilbert
is in the City now and has addressed a

did not want him, so I heard,

Parsus is here, figuring largely
quite a crowd after him, yet I think
we will stand the meeting shock &
perhaps pass it without being destroyed
Things are moving in smoothly, in our
work, Br. Barrett is dead, died last Sat
last, I have no news,
