I write you a few days
since ^{which} has reached you before this, And without
wishing to be troublesome, permit me to
introduce to your acquaintance my friend
Capt. J. M. Humphrey of this place, who is a
respectable member of our church, and now
visits Columbus as a lobby member for the
purpose of attending to the interests of a
new county that we wish to have made
in this particular section of the State at the
Session of our Legislature. Mr. Humphrey
will no doubt wish during his stay at the
Seat of Government to accompany you to
your congregation in the State Prison which
if not incompatible with the regulations of the
Institution I know will be agreeable to you both.
He can inform you what the public sentiment
is in reference to the conviction of the two
Individuals viz. Snyder & Devine, to whom
I alluded in my former communication.
Any attention shown to Mr. Humphrey will
