Dear Brother we are Moderately well thanks be to God for his Mercies to us I received your letter Requesting me to send you the amount of your land tax here which is \$10-83 the of Receiving tax will be out the 20th day of this month the tax Receiver is Brother in law to Mr Eaton of Canonsburgh And he says that he thinks that he can get him to take the tax Money after the time is out and Cost you no More he wood have sent the \$10-83 if had it by him Mr George Bridgman is Doing Right with the 10 acre lease he took Frederick Bridgman the old Man has not full fill'd his Contract he has only Cleard of And put in about 3 acres he Made Shugan last Spring on your Sand without any liberty we have our Meeting house Coverd Wether Corded und floor laid and look for you next Spring or Summer if you Can Come and will Prefere the Dedication Service till you Come if you Can Come let us know and I will give you what account of your land here As I Can and Remain your brother and friend in the Lord
