Alonzo Wade.

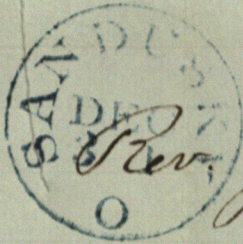
I have nothing of special interest in religious matters to communicate, but we are laboring and praying for a revival of the work of God.

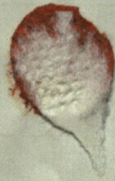
