March 17th 1848

Dear Bro Finley

The Methodists of Pleasant Valley expect to complete a neat little brick meeting house against the 22^d of April, at which time we intend to hold our third quarterly meeting and the dedication of the house in connection with it. Your assistance is solicited by our folks in that place, also it is Brother Groves and my own request, to have you with us upon the occasion, which meeting I trust will be made a blessing to the place. The Universalists have a M house on the way for more than two years in the same village, and as our brethren have got the start in building we wish to give them a good lift at the dedication meeting. The house will probably be about \$150 in debt when it is finished, the object is to raise this amount at the dedication. I suppose you know where the place is therefore I need give you no directions.

You will please write to me immediately and let me know whether you are coming. Give my best respects to Bro & Sister Dewey I have not forgotten their kindness to us during our conference.
