Mansfield O. June 12- 1848

Rev. J. B. Finley Dear Brother.

After my best Respects to you permit me (while here on business from my Circuit) to ask a favour at your hands which is the following (Viz) My son is in need of Blackstones ^{Commentary} ~~Principles~~ and Kent's Commentary (Law Books) and I thought I could procure them for him in this place but find I cannot; and am informed I cannot get them nearer than your City and ^{know} no one there save yourself that I thought I could trouble with the business save yourself I take the liberty to ask of you ^{if you} please to call and enquire at your Book store & write me what books they can be had and what they will cost and drop me a line (my address is Millersburg Holmes Co.) & if he cannot get them before I will forward you the money and ask you to forward them by stages yours in the bonds of the gospel of peace
