Beaver July 27th 1848

Dear Brother

I have been waiting with
anxiety for a few lines from you
in reference to the prospect of
my Son being received into the
Insane Hospital at Columbus; he was
a Citizen of Ohio in Portage County.
I took him from there in an insane
state of Mind and has so remained
to the present. I am very desirous
that he should be put under proper
treatment so if possible he might
be restored to a sane mind; he is about
thirty years of age, and has good health
if not crossed is generally quiet. I shall
recede as a favor if you will inform
me on this subject. I remain your
