Dear Brother

Yours of the 18th August, on the subject of the land in Indiana came duly to hand.

In it you say "that if the Timber lot can be bought at any reasonable price it will be done - if it cannot - then it must be settled in some other equitable and just way - but it will take some time - I cannot make any compromise with you until I can see what others will do &c".

I hope you will be able to put me in possession ^{of the Timber lot} bought of you - inasmuch as I was compelled to invest all my means - and go in debt - to buy the intervening lots of Read to join the ^{two} lots which I was to get of you ^{as intended}.

I expect to keep the Prairie lot I got of you as it ^{is} ~~was~~ what you represented it to be - you will please therefore confine your negotiations to the Timber Lot alone.

I hope you will shape matters so as to do something definite by conference - inasmuch as I expect to start for Indiana the day after conference closes. It will be very desirable to settle it before I leave.
