Sept 10th 1848

Dear Gents & friends i am on my way to east
my health is bad but i pray love will spare and
protect us all it is with feelings of the deepest
gratitude that I would address you when i get
to pennsylvania i shall attach myself to church
and try to make my way to heaven my time
may be short at all events please remember
me kindly to Mrs Rice, Johnson. hwy &c -
and I must say Mrs Dewey kindness to the
female prisoners as well as Mr Dewees conduct
towards the males is beyond goodness & our heart
of in any place Excuse my bad miserable
hurred scrawl yours

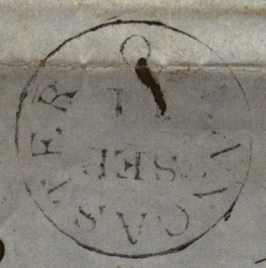
