Sept 10th 1848

Dear Gents & friends i am on my way to east
my health is bad but i pray lord will spare and
protect us all it is with feelings of the deepest
gratitude that I would address you when i get
to pennsylvania i shall attack myself to church
and try to make my way to heaven my time
may be short at all events please remember
me kindly to Mrs Rice Johnson Lucy &c -
and I must say Mrs Dewey finds nsp to the
female prisoners as wile Mr Deweys conduct
towards the males is beyond goodness i ever heard
of in any place Because my bad misfortune
turned schrole yours
