Dayton Oct 30th 1848

Mr J B Finley
Dear Sir, Your letter came
to hand this morning, I have sent from \$200. to
\$300. on hand for you for several weeks, and
came past Mr Bowers house some Thursday
ago I called to him from the stage asking
in his potato patch, and tried to make
him understand this, but the stage was going
my fast and perhaps he did not know
me or hear what I said, I have since
written to him, but he has not been or sent
for the money. I should have had all your
money, but Mr Martin my Attorney at
Delamington had collected about \$500. for
me and was on his way bringing it to me
when he lost his book and my money
I shall have to wait a little while on him
now, I have just been to see him, and he
says he will refund it before Christmas
at the farthest, of this you may be satisfied
I am as anxious to pay you as you are to
receive your money, and particularly so
because when you are paid I shall be clear
of debt. My family has been sick and I am
sorry or I should have taken the money and
it will be ready when you come
