

I have just received a letter from the Grand Series, informing me that a special session of the Grand Division will be held at Foster Hall in the city of Cincinnati on Thursday next at 3 o'clock P.M. ~ I shall leave here to-morrow morning, and spend Wednesday in Columbus, leave there on Wednesday night in the stage, and reach Cincinnati in the Thursday morning train. ~ Now my dear sir I hope you will make your arrangements to go with me, ~ I would have given you notice earlier if I had received it myself ~ I hope to be at the ^{Neil House} ~~Andersons~~ in your city on Tuesday night and will be happy to see you. ~

The election of Genl Taylor is now a "fixed fact" ~ we shall have an honest man once more in the Presidential chair ~
