Dear Bro

I wrote to you by the Mail of last Saturday - requesting you to forward to me by Mail the certificate of deposit of \$7500 - which you informed me by letter - you had deposited in the City Bank - Columbus - subject to my order on the return of the certificate aforesaid.

Since my last letter - I learned that Gen<sup>l</sup> Mc Cracken would leave here for your place this morning & return on Wednesday Morn<sup>g</sup> by stage.

I have made arrangements with him to deposit \$5000 in the aforesaid Bank for me - and <sup>with you \$7500</sup> ~~and~~ <sup>to</sup> ~~draw~~ a draft <sup>in my favour</sup> on the Franklin Bank of Cin<sup>ti</sup> - for \$12500 - the amount of my Note to Esq<sup>r</sup> Parkinson - Indiana

If you have not mailed the certificate to me - please hand it to Gen<sup>l</sup> Mc Cracken for which he will give you a receipt in my behalf.

If this should not reach you - before his return - so that he cannot make the above arrangement - you will confer a favour by forwarding the certificate to me by Mail as soon as possible - as I shall be compelled to return it - with \$50 - added to the City Bank Columbus - get a draft on Cin<sup>ti</sup> - forward it there - make deposit in Franklin Bank and get their certificate and forward it to Indiana - which will consume much time - in all at least 3 weeks -

We are in the midst of a glorious revival - mourning at the Altar every night last week but one - Prospect brightens still - we have ten thousand congregations - last night our large church crowded - Yours respectfully - Granville Moody

You will find Gen<sup>l</sup> Mc Cracken at the "American"
