Dear Bro

Received yours of 23rd ult & was
glad to hear from you - but sorry to hear of your
treatment - I am not sorry that I left the institu-
tion for I have such a contemptible opinion of that
Man & his principles you do not know what
I do of him & Deney seems to think him all perfe-
ction he Mr you may recollect bought 2 old
Horn from Burdell Cost about \$120 said to be
worth \$50 but a lot of poor dogs of the same
name now at I think \$100 or more pr each than they
could be but for in Market this to accomodate
a friend - I believe Deney to be an honest
man but easy led away I think he cannot sustain
himself much longer

Sure Sir do you did
say to me they the board had agreed to pay your
board & fee your horse & your washing done
by the females the above to the best of my
knowledge in his language Mr Deney
did say to me he would give you your
board I said to him the Directors had
agreed to pay it & let them do it he
said they had been very cruel to
him & he would not charge the state
with the more I do that much himself
for the Elder was a great benefit to us

I believe all would be well now if it was not
for Mr - I have long since fixed my opinion
about him - I would be glad to see you
at my house we are all well My Boys are
here with me quite healthy George is married
