German Towne Aug 31 1849

Rev - Sir

Yesterday Mr Mutchner & myself came to this place
to attend to that abstraction but as yet
Walker is not here but is expected by the
stage at 11 o'clock. The men all well at
Home yesterday nothing new at home
or in the neighborhood the children
are going to school James & Charles are
well James & Fisher were here frid last
Elizath Valley is dead (Fisher's daughter
at Nazareth)

as soon as I get Home I shall write
you as to what was done in your
claims against the trustees here.
Mr Lipe Williams is going to Springfield
to the Grand division and I suppose
you would be there
no more at present but you
as ever until death
