

Lockport June 9<sup>th</sup> - 1849

Dr Bro

I am now on my way to Depla  
n with a load of lumber we are all  
tolerable well though the hearing of the  
hand my wife has better health  
here than she did in Columbus our  
town is improving very fast I think  
there is about 18 or 20 houses going  
up it is thought there will be 30  
this year I believe there is not 1 sick  
person in Cleva - Croton was married  
last Thursday night to Miss ~~A. A.~~ denison  
& C. Mayo or sisters daughter of Mr  
Kileyo they had a great wedding  
they had ~~a~~ all the best cloth & silk of  
St Mary at it they shone me much  
respect but I fit salure on account of my  
lost affliction in my family  
air some mill clear us about \$0 to \$60  
per week but there is a great demand for  
lumber in the town & neighborhood &  
there we do not realize much cash but  
the pay is good & will come in by & by  
we are now naming for Judge  
Hall who has a good farm here near  
town at \$0 per 100 feet he has 20 logs

I am building again I hope to have it  
ready by July to get in to & I hope  
to see you here to stay with me a week  
for I intend to put a little chamber to  
it for the Mass of God to rest his many limbs  
I am now in a cabin I could not stand the  
2 family there our great Mill will be  
up in a few weeks, I wish you would sell  
my house and let there be a Morgan on  
it to the firm commisioner of 373<sup>1/2</sup> it ought to  
sell for \$1000 it now rents for 75<sup>1/2</sup> & might  
of been rented 100<sup>1/2</sup> if one more room had  
been plastered I hope to pay down some  
time next month if the Lord willing
