Home Feb 25<sup>th</sup>

Rev Sir

When in Gannon town I drop'd you a line  
by Mr Wilson but then knew nothing about  
your business that evening the Met  
and Quet an array of Trustees Witness &c  
and about 8 o'clock they told their opinion  
which was to allow you \$146 & some cent  
Walker then agreed to give the Trustees \$60  
paid Bro Metchum 5 and then said they  
would give their Note for 87 & something  
in a year time so I left it but  
Just now I rec'd a line from Walker

said he found there would be trouble
