Augusta, Bracken County, Ky.,
May 3rd 1849.

Rev. of Dear Sir: You are aware that by an act of the Legislature of Kentucky, last winter, the charter of Augusta College will be forfeited on the first of June proximo, unless against that time, certain conditions are complied with by the Trustees. Members of the Board of this place consider it very important to all the interests involved, that there should be a full meeting of the Trustees and Visiting Committee as soon as practicable to confer together as to the most proper steps to be taken in the premises, and have designated Friday the 11th of this month for that purpose, at which time you are very respectfully and earnestly requested to be present, at 10 O'clock A. M.
