Columbus Dec. 29<sup>th</sup> 1825

Dear Brother

In haste I drop you a few lines, I am well for which I feel thankful.

There is a Bill before the Legislature to organize Crawford County, I wish to know of you if the Interest of that County will be advanced by the passage of the Bill or not, or whether you would prefer remaining as you are. If you wish to have it organized say whether you are of Opinion the permanent seat of Justice should be established now or only a temporary seat & in either case where you would wish to have it located.
