Concannate May 10. 1823

Dear Broo! Yours dated Apr 20th came
to hand in due time, I rejoice to hear of your
success among the Indians. my sincere prayer is
that God may crown your labours among them more
abundantly, I somewhat regret that I cannot comply
with your request and pay you a visit at this
time, for I can assure you it would give me
much satisfaction, but such is the state affairs
in this station at present that Broo Cummins
thinks it unexpedient for me to be absent.

Broo Wright therefore starts this morning with the
design of getting the money conveyed out or
got taking out himself. We shall expect you
to come & see us before Conf — and spend
some time with us, I want to see you very much.
I have many things to tell you I have not
time to write any more at present
