by health has bin improving for some weeks past
and at present my health is pretty good. Rebecca's
health is tolerable, as it respects my self I think
with care I shall be able to preach the last quarter
and I have written a letter to Oxford informing them

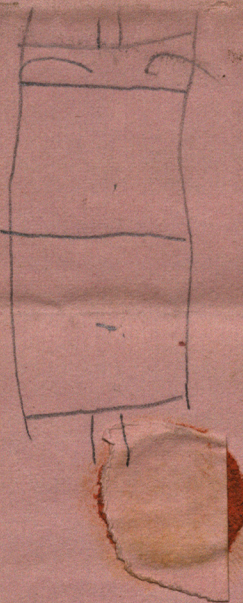
