will be necessary to bring us out of our sleep.

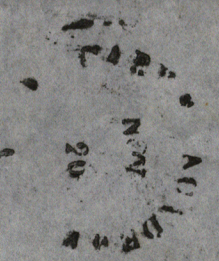
The hearts of many have grown cold and
