Cincinnati May 30 1836

Dear Bro Finley

agreeably to your request I write to let you know that the Ohio conference will be held on the 28th of Sept we will try and have the whole plan published this week Michigan will be on the 7th of Sept.

I would not have ^{you} to be discouraged about the western book concern. in which I know you feel a deep interest. It is true we are not at liberty to print any work stereotyped in N. York and on account of the failure of your resolution the agents of New York are not bound to send us any printed sheets unless they choose to do so. The broad foundation obtained gives us an advantage and I think we will be able to manage the matter with the agents (reason and some whom I consider reasonable men) without much difficulty.
