We shall expect to see you shortly, as you
proposed in your last letter to come down,
when the books should be ready. We shall be
glad to see you & to do the very best we can
for the unfortunate under your charge in
the way of supplying them with good books.

Bro. Groomstedt is absent, having been to
the Pittsburg Cong. His family is with him.
We expect him home the last of this week
or first of next. He wrote that it was
possible he wd spend next Sabbath in Marietta.

We have nothing of special interest
about the Book room or in the city. The
brethren & friends generally are well.

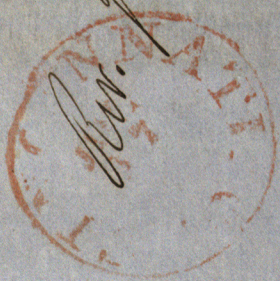
