Bloomfield Sept 24 1829

Dear Uncle

About one and half year
since I wrote you a long letter but
as yet have not received an answer
from you I presume the letter must come
a few days since Mother received
a letter from you by the hand of her Eldest
we rejoice that though you have been
afflicted that your dear wife's health
is on the mend. and hope it will still
continue to improve.

Mother came out here last
spring one year since her health is not
very good. She has three attacks of
diseases one last year one in the winter
and one this fall. She is now convalescent
she is not very satisfied with the country
thinks it to cold & wintry.

Catharine lived about 60
years from us in Trenton, New Jersey
her health is not good it has been
quite bad for the last 5 years
her constitution is completely broken
and she moves like a woman of
fifty. She has four children living.
she has lost 3 of her children in
trials of moving to Arkansas this fall
or next spring but I think it doubtful.

Two years since an acquaintance
of mine who had just returned from
Oregon states that a man calling
himself Sam Henry from Oregon was at
West Philadelph station in supposed

whether this was Cousin Law or not I
do not know. I wrote to Davis Read &
Robt. Finley but never receive any answer
from either of them. Perhaps the news

would rather sit over his books than
to work. I intend to give them all
trades. train them up in habits of industry
and with good education they will
make their way in the world.

west of the Mississippi. The town is now
so rapidly increasing. one of the country
is destined to be one of richest in the

settled in this part of the adjoining country

family are well and doing so well
as should be very much to see
you all here. You are living in the Palmer
field. Surrounded by your children

Mormon is living with me
she talks some of going back to Africa
it is very hard for the old to form

an old as I should have to be one hundred
years old. I think I should feel as though
