Euphemia March 13th 1853

Dear Uncle

It is with pleasure that I sit down to write to you and would of done so before but when Cliff was over she said that you wear a coming ~~over~~ to Eaton the next week and I expected you over but as you do not come I ^{will} answer your letter I was glad to receive it for I did not know where to direct my letter, it is Sunday and I have just come from Sunday School we have a very good one the ~~Brethren~~ here Lutheren have a protracted meeting it commenced ~~Friday~~ ^{of} day evening and I suppose it will continue this week. Mrs Harris has gone to New York she has been ~~there~~ ^{there} two weeks and expects to return this I find Mr and Mrs Haras very pleasant people ~~Mrs~~ Harris thinks I learn very fast we have not worked much at straw this winter but have made over one hundred silk and satin ^{bonnets} I have made two I run the shear in a great many and have learnt to braid and and change the shape I received a letter from home some time ago they ~~were~~ well then but Mr ~~W~~ Washburn is ^{dead} the local preacher

as the school teacher perhaps you know him
well uncle I ~~love~~ must close as it supper
time when you go home come over to see us
I want to see you very much I do not
expect you can read this but try
we have a post office in P. u. p. h. e. n. i. a

no more at present
