Washington

Sept. 7. 1826

My dear friend,

I enclose you the
receipt requested in your letter,
and have ordered the paper dis-
continued at the end of the
year.

My family enjoy reasonable health.
They have been afflicted with pre-
vailing colds, but nearly recovered.
Your Cap stated to me the other
day that you had lately experienced
a severe affliction. I hope the
accident is not correct - but, if it
be true, there is still a hope that
afflictions can never destroy and
that is, that they shall work for
you a far more exceeding &
eternal weight of Glory.

My family will visit Ohio next summer. I am overwhelmed with business both night and day. When a moment of leisure occurs I will write more at large.

My family join me in love to you and yours.
