Dear Sir,

I hope that it may not be important for me to give a positive answer as to Dickland at this time. Until I see William who will be here next month, I cannot say what disposition will be made of father & mother, until which time, it will not be in my power to say whether Bishop I can occupy my house or not. If father & mother should leave it, I should like to procure some one to take it, who will keep the house as in repair. I am told it is now, much out of repair. My family are in usual health except Rebecca Jun. who is somewhat unwell. Mr Blair's family are well. All give in affectionate remembrance to you & yours
