Newark Ohio June 15th 1847
Dear Brother Finley

we did not find it convenient
to start your box of books for four or five days
after you left but finally got them off.
after you left here I obtained from Schumaker
3 volumes from Mrs Sherwood 9 volumes all
of which are in the box

our last quarterly meeting is now over
we had a very pleasant meeting Mr gemison
was with us though quite lame. I told him
that you talked of visiting Lancaster, Rushville
and Somerset which he was glad to hear
and will assist you if you call on him

Mr gemison is very anxious to see you and
wishes if ~~you~~ go to Somerset you would
drop him a line and let him know
when you will be there that he may be
at home.
