Dayton Oct 21st 1846

Dear Brother,

I received a letter a few days since from Doctor Prigham Corresponding Secretary of the American Bible Society at New York informing me that my request to have one hundred large Testaments for the use of your convicts in the State Prison would soon be complied with. If you have not received them, you may expect them soon. They will be sent I presume through the Franklin County Auxiliary Enquire of the Depository at Whitings and Huntingtons. Give my love to bro & sister Moody. Tell Moody to join the Sons of Temperance as soon as possible. Write me dear brother and be assured of my fraternal regards.
