Dear brother:— You requested the publishers
some time since, through the columns of The W
C Advocate to send you good books for
the use of the prisoners. I am collecting a
few to send by our senator, B Mackall, &
among them are three Bibles. Some one
said to me, a few days ago, that Bibles
were not needed, each being supplied with
one by the State. If this be so I would
like to know it & in that case, would try
to exchange the Bibles I have for other
books. Please write & let me know.

When at Zanesville you said you
had at home, & would send to me a
volume written by a M'Donald of Poplar
Ridge, Ky., made up of thrilling incidents of
border warfare. I suppose you have forgotten
it, or lacked opportunity. Could you send it
by our treasurer, if he should call for it? I
would like to have it to copy (if the author
would permit) some of its tales for the P & Advoca-
te, for variety to its readers.

Would Temperance newspapers be of
any use to you?

My health is not very good. My
family is well. Please write soon.
