Please say to Mr. Baker that
I have just returned from an interview with the
Gov: who asked two or three hours since.

And he has declined acting on any more
Pardons during the period that yet will elapse
of his Executive Expiration

But being fully sensible of the doubtful nature
of Mr. Baker's guilt he has promised me to use his
influence with Gov. Cobb who will be duly installed
into his office next month when I will again come
up and renew my efforts for a pardon.

I have left my papers & propositions &c on file
and have great hopes of success.

Tell Baker to trust in God who if he is innocent
will deliver him in due time.
