Pittsburgh Jan 27 1849

Dear Brother,

I have this day received  
your communication respecting the correspondence  
of Geo. W. Jackson, and I frankly confess  
I have no language to express my contempt  
for such conduct; I wish you would by return  
of Mail enclose me the Letter so that I may  
place it before him, as I have been convinced  
some time that he would repay as all by the  
Basest ingratitude, he resides a near neighbor  
to me and as I have his Brothers estate in hand  
I can easily have access to him, and show him  
his real character, which be assured I shall  
do, if you should wish I will hold myself  
responsible for the return of his letter at any time  
I wish to have it to see the hand writing, and if  
his bring it before his eyes, I shall be glad when  
I have done with him, as I have no confidence  
in him whatever, Burns might well say, "Man  
inhumanity to Man makes countless thousands mourn."
