Dear Brother Quincy

Enclosed Return you the  
 Letter & Account of Geo. W. Jackson, as soon as  
 I received it I found who was the Writer, I forthwith

 It appears that the Account was for Jowls furnished  
 by Mr Jackson to the Prison when he was killing  
 in Columbus, and of course you could not know  
 he was from this place. I am truly glad that

 said a word to him about, and cannot tell  
 how he came to know and write to you  
 All Friends here are well, I shall be glad to  
 serve you at any time in my power, we  
 have some glorious times here in our Churches  
 More good is being done this winter than for  
 many years
