When I came to this place I joined the church with my wife and we are now in good standing in the church and I am settled in the Sunday school and ~~am~~ am doing well at my business, I follow house painting and have three hands in my employ and as much work as we can do. I am living on Everett street opposite the free school in Hartmann's house on the second floor and if you should come down here I should be happy to have you call and see me without fail. I was at camp meeting last year and enquired for you but you was not there and I was some disappointed if it will not be too much trouble to you I should like to have you write to me by my wife as she will be in your place about a week. Please tender my best respects to my many shopmates and all enquiring friends and to Col. Sewer and Mr. Deafor in particular.
