Cranfordsville July 12th 1852.

Dear Brother Finley.

My love to you and yours.

My reasons for troubling you with a scrap at this time is are the following. We have in contemplation a Campmeeting for the Ladaga and Middletown Circuits conjointly, commencing on the 27th of August next which meeting will be holden on my premises (6 miles south of Cranfordsville) to unto which meeting we in the name of and at the solisitation of our Brethren and for our selfe do most cordialy affectionethly and presingly invite you to come, if you possibly can. We will make all the arrangements nessary for your commenance and comforte, with any of your family, or any others whom you may bring with you. Bring a Quantity of your Books (Prison Life) with you they will meet with a ready sale. Our Conference will commence on the week after the meeting closes which we also wish you to attend. Come if you possibly can, many of your old friends are hear, and are very anxious to see you, and have the privilage of being at another Campmeeting with the old Chief, before he goes to join the Hosts above. Write Write us immediately and let us know whether you can come or not
