Sharonville March 26<sup>th</sup> 1833

Dear Bro. Finley,

you were informed, by Bro  
Magroone, as to the wishes of the, last Temperance  
meeting, that is an ardent desire, that you  
would be with us at our next meeting,  
which is next Friday, or the first day of  
April, I hope you have made your  
arrangements to be with us, The audi-  
ence, though well entertained were dis-  
appointed at our last meeting, It seemd  
to be generally expected that you would  
address us, I wish also to say to you  
and to present a request, if possible,  
that you would stay with us over  
Sabbath, as it is the time of our second  
Quarterly meeting, to be holden at West  
chester, only 4 miles distant from  
Sharon, and a good Turnpike road—  
you had better come out in the Sebano  
n. Buss— or stage, though if you come  
on the Rail road, Let me know by  
letter, so that we can send a conveyance,  
for you,
