New Carlisle Nov 9th 1846

Esteemed Friend & Brother

Understanding that you have become a Brother of the Sons of Temperance, and as we are again to dedicate our new Hall Friday Evening the 27th inst and the Ladies of our Village presents our order with a Bible at 2 oc of said day. I take the liberty of inviting you to be present on that occasion and deliver a Publick address on the great subject of Temperance. Many of your friend have expressed an anxiety to hear you I know of no one who has laboured longer & harder than you have for Temperance and I might add that has born more persecution than your self. our Division now 452 members we have hoped to see you by Gath.

If you can not be present please write a communication on that subject that I may have it read.
