Clarksburgh March 4, 1848

 Temperance No. 276 I drop you a few lines as the ardent desire
 that you and Mr. Gallaway address the Sons of Temperance
 in Clarksburgh at a collation on the 11. or 12. or 13. or 14. or 15. of April next
 Any of those days will suit our preachers for they are both Sons and
 about like to be present, these will be invited Chill, Circle, Frankfort
 Bloomingburgh New Holland & Williamsport Division &c
 Have made arrangements for your Reception from Circleville
 or New Holland with ease can arrange by your coming to
 either of those places by stage, stating the place and day so as we
 can be at either place ready and all expenses paid by us
 We have built a Temperance Hall in Clarksburgh 40. by 18 feet
 from the stump in about 7 weeks No. at first 11. and
 now 45- or 50 out of this No. & drunkards in their late minds
 going to Church with their voices look like men in stead of ~~men~~
 broods thank God for the Institution I do think it one
 of the best of all the best Temperance plans to sober
 man kind, Bro Linley fail not if possible to besist
 us I remain yours in the bonds of love in Christ
