Newark April 16th 1849

Father Finley

At the last meetings of our divisions a
Committee was appointed (of which I am Chairman) to
invite you to deliver a public Temperance lecture
at our hall on next Monday evening on your
way to the Grand Division at Zanesville & I trust
your arrangements will permit you to accept the
invitation. & I have no doubt that a lecture from
you on that subject in our town will be produc-
tive of much good. Let me arrange the mat-
ter. Come over on Saturday - preach to our people
on the Sabbath - talk temperance on Monday night
and on Tuesday we will go to Zanesville. If
however it is important to be with your people
on the Sabbath then come over on Monday. But
whether you come on Saturday or Monday remem-
ber that our house is to be your home.

Please write immediately that we may give
the necessary notice, and we will have a house
full. Don't forget to bring the Red books
Royalist &c.
