Dear Bro. Finley,      Lawrenceburg, July 2<sup>d</sup>. 1847

I meant to communicate ~~last~~  
week before last hoping to meet you on your  
attendance at the meeting of the Book Com.  
but was sorry that you were necessarily  
detained. I write now to say to you that  
I expect (God willing) to be at your  
Conf. perhaps not until the 2<sup>d</sup> day, and  
as I suppose that you may be crowded in  
Columbus at that time I thought it best  
to let you know, for I have sometimes  
found it difficult to provide for brethren  
at Conf. who were not expected.

I thank you for the part you took in the  
East Ohio Conf. in the invitation for my  
return amongst you. Indeed, I have been  
longer under you than any other man, and  
Exhorter, Local Preacher & Itinerant — you licensed  
me to preach, and to this day I seem to  
occupy, more the position of a son, than that  
of a junior Bro. I have rec<sup>d</sup>. a certificate  
of transfer to the Ohio Conf. from Bp. Hamline  
to take effect at the session of your Conf.

I suppose that all that will be necessary for  
for me to do, will be, to bring a representation  
of my Character from my P. E. and to notify  
the President of the Indiana Conf. of my transfer.  
If you think of any thing else that is necessary  
please write & let me know.

We are in pretty good health — my own health is  
as good as it ever was, and I can report  
myself as ready for any work & any place, whether  
as I shall be obliged to visit Indiana once or  
twice a year for a year or two, ~~on~~ business,  
I hope they will give me an appt. somewhere  
on the Western border

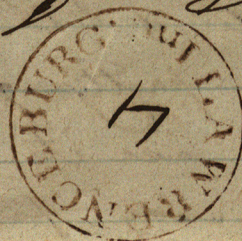
