Dear Sir

I have finished my business with Mr. Montgomery and the Indians here, and shall set out tomorrow morning for Wooster and thence to Pittsburg. have got an Indian to accompany me for three or four days probably as far as Wooster, or until I come up with some conveyance. Stephen the beaver is on the return, will trouble you a night and want a little provision to carry him forward. I will not fail to advise you of my movements from time to time. my best regards to Mrs. Finley and many thanks for your and her kindness.
