May 16. 1825.

Dear Sir.

I am just informed that Gov<sup>r</sup> Cass has arrived at Wapaghkonetta to hold the Council with the Indians on the subject of removing to the west of the Mississippi. I will set out for there to day do not know how long I shall be detained. I have written by this mail to Mr. Montgomery that I shall pay the Indians at Upper Sandusky on the 9<sup>th</sup> of June. and if nothing turns up in the mean time you may expect that I shall be there at that time. please to give notice to all the Wyandots at Sandusky and Big Spring and else where. There is some particular business to be done with John Sammers Hairs which renders it necessary that I should attend in person
