Dear Sir.

Upper Piqua

Aug. 30. 1825

The person whom I had engaged to take the Load to Sandusky of Iron Steel &c has a son lying in the Fever, which has prevented his starting as soon as I had expected. He will proceed as soon as he can leave home. By the waggon I will send you some Bibles & Testaments for the school. I received a donation lately from the Philadelphia Bible society for distribution or for sale as the case may be

I have been for some time at Cincinnati and returned home unwell. We have had several cases of Fever in this neighborhood, and some deaths. The season however is not so unhealthy as formerly
