Honesville Feb. 20. 1826.

Dear Sir.

The bearer, Capt. Cass, repairs to Upper Sandusky to assume the duties of Sub Agent. I have directed him to call upon you, to give him such instruction & information, respecting the situation of affairs at that place, as may be necessary to enable him to understand the duties required of him; & to discharge them with fidelity. Your counsel & advice will always be useful to him, & I trust will be favorably received by him.

You will please to bring the Indians to a Council, & introduce him to them officially, as the officer

Charged with the protection of their
interests. - I enclose a letter which
I wish to have read to the Chiefs.
