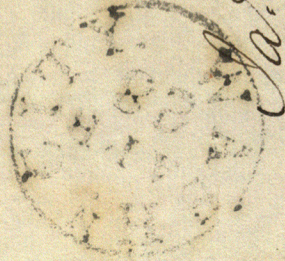

In reply to your Letter of the 23rd Oct^r,
last, I have to state, that no account of your
Disbursements for the Civilization of Indians
has as yet been received, and that consequently
you stand charged with the whole amount transmitted
to you, and that no adjustment can take place
until an account detailing the Disbursements properly
certified is received at this Office. A Letter from
the Presiding Member or other Representative of
the Bishops & Ministers composing the Ohio annual
Conference approving your statement as referred to
in your Letter of the 23rd Oct^r as aforesaid will be
sufficient in making a Requisition of this kind
of you, I beg you will not consider as implying
any doubt as to the propriety of your Disbursements,
the Requisitions require it of all persons entrusted
with the Disbursement of public moneys

and it cannot be dispensed with unless
otherwise specially directed -
